

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

Accommodations: An outdoor rain fly will be set up for a covered gathering area. Bring your own tent and rain fly—tenting is a necessity!

Activities: Gold planning, hiking, target shooting, rafting, and photography.

Age Limit: There are no age restrictions for the 2025 retreat.

Clothing: Come prepared for cool nights and rain; one never knows.

Meals: Bring your own backpacking food, cooking gear, stove and cookware.

Musical Instruments: Share your talents—the more the merrier!

Pets: Please leave them at home. This is not the venue to bring pets.

Transportation: Logistics require that unless you have your own transportation, you must attend all days of the retreat. Transportation options include:

- **Hiking:** 13 miles one-way on a four-wheeler trail (shorter and rougher than the trail below).
- **Four-Wheelers:** 22 miles/1.5 hour trip on a four-wheeler. Don't have a four-wheeler? Contact Alaska Toy Rentals 907-775-1800.
- **Guides:** Contact Jeff Burnette for additional information.
- **Fly-in:** Cost is \$300 per person/round-trip; \$150 per person/one-way. Contact Mike Meekin at Meekin's Air Service to schedule your flight to camp at 907-745-1626 or on the web at www.meekinsairservice.com.

- Use designated outhouses; one at the airstrip or one at the cabin.
- Clean up after yourself. Kent Sandvik has graciously allowed us to use his camp; let's keep it clean.
- Keep ATV's off the runway and watch for air traffic!
