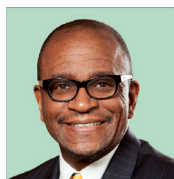

### SABBATH PARKING AND TRAFFIC

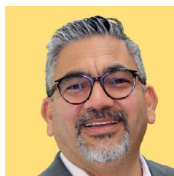
