Throughout the last couple of months, we have been studying who Jesus is according to the book of John. In this book are 7 “I Am” statements and 7 miracles boldly articulating the nature of Christ and His purpose for us.

In the final chapters John finally summarizes his reason for writing the book saying, “but these are written so that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that by believing you may have life in his name” (ESV).

John knew that each act he included would form a comprehensive argument proving that one’s belief in Jesus is the only thing that can welcome that person into “life.” No letter of the law nor mighty human act has the power to receive one into salvation.
