Brentwood School Upcoming Events:

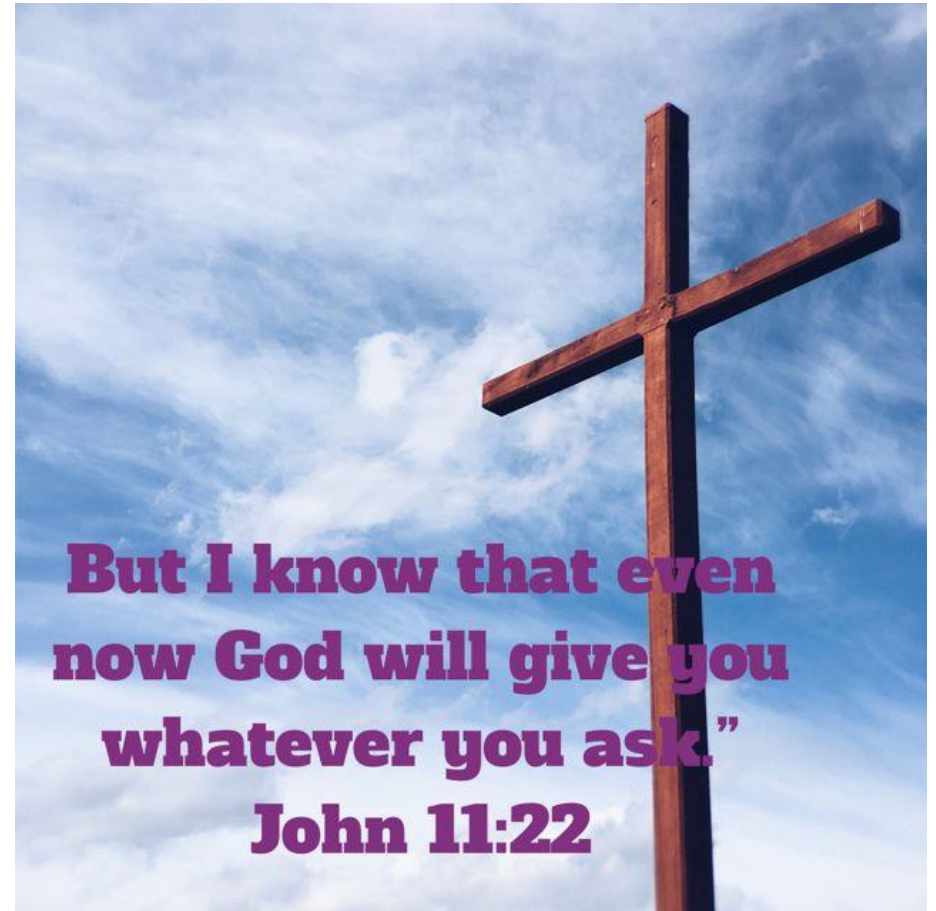
- School Board Meeting, April 11th, 6:30 pm at Brentwood

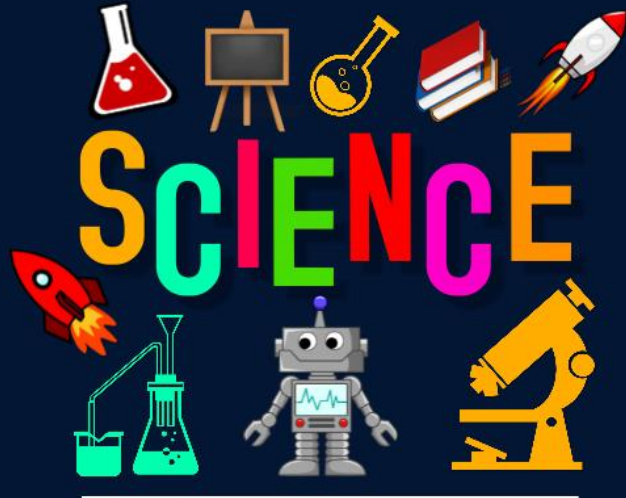
