Small Groups:

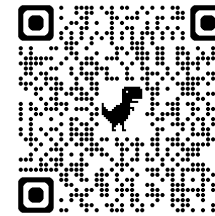

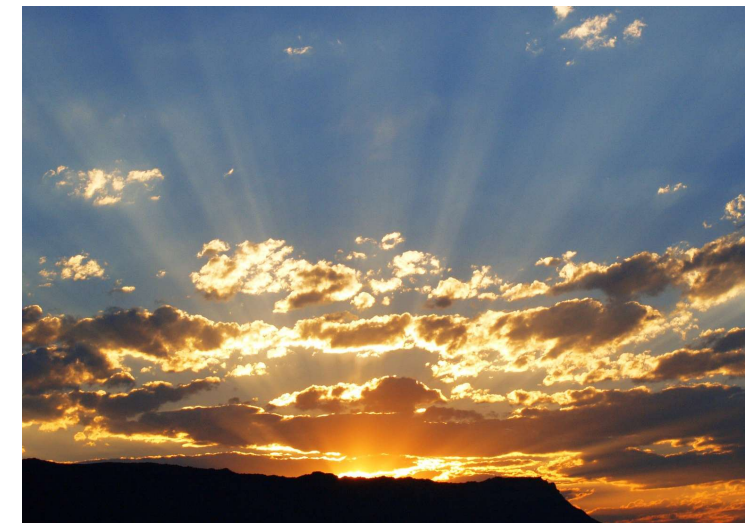
