## Pastor’s Corner

This week, we step into two very different gardens. One feels strangely familiar, the other gloriously hopeful. Eden reveals the uncomfortable truth about us. We know what’s right, feel the pressure, and too often wobble like Macbeth in that quiet room where he talks himself in circles before making the worst decision in English literature. If you've ever looked back at a choice and thought, what was I thinking? Congratulations, you know Eden.

Scripture refuses to leave us there. It takes us to Gethsemane, where Jesus stands in the place we once fell. While Adam and Eve reached for the fruit, Jesus reached for the Father. While Eden reveals disobedience under pressure, Gethsemane reveals obedience despite crushing weight.

The good news is simple. Christ stood where humanity fell short. His obedience breaks the cycle of our failure. His victory gives us a place to rest. It’s like when a friend says, 'Do not worry, it is already taken care of,' and you actually believe them.

As we approach communion today, we do so not as perfect people, but as people thankful for a perfect Savior. The bread and cup remind us that where fear rises, faith stands, because Christ stood first. May you find rest, hope, and courage in the garden where victory was won.
