Pastor’s Corner: A Spirit of Reconciliation

As we begin our prophecy series, I have been thinking a lot about how we deal with our enemies, or perhaps more honestly, those we just struggle to get along with. Human nature makes it easy to turn our backs on people who disappoint us, disagree with us, or simply rub us the wrong way. But the gospel calls us to something higher.

Christ did not tell us to love only those who think like us or agree with us. He said, “Love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you.” That is not easy. It is far more comfortable to avoid awkward conversations or to quietly hold a grudge. Yet when we do that, the body of Christ becomes divided, and our mission loses its power.

This week, as we focus on sharing the good news of Jesus’ soon return, I want to invite you to join me in praying for the spirit of reconciliation. Let us ask God to help us follow the counsel of Matthew 18, to approach one another directly, in humility and love, seeking understanding instead of distance.

My prayer is that nothing will stand in the way of our common mission, that every relationship in our church will reflect the grace and unity of Christ. When we are reconciled to one another, the gospel we preach becomes more than words, it becomes a living testimony of God’s transforming love.

In Daniel 11 the 3rd conflict immediately precedes the coming of Christ. This seminar is not about doom and gloom but about how we can be at peace in a crazy world and live without fear. This seminar gives the needed information to effectively live for God in these difficult times. Unlike other seminars which focus on the past and distant future, this seminar focuses on how prophecy is currently being fulfilled right before our eyes. However, since most have not studied Daniel 11, they sleep on in dangerous ignorance.
