Pastor’s Corner:

Following our prophecy series this week, I found myself reflecting on the concept of being caught in the middle. It’s not a comfortable place to be. When two friends argue, you feel pulled in both directions, trying not to disappoint either one. Growing up in a divorced home, I know that tension all too well. Two people who once loved each other now expect you to pick a side. Holidays like Thanksgiving and Christmas often became painful because, no matter where I went, someone felt hurt that I chose to be with the other parent.

As I think about this, I realize it’s a fitting picture of what God’s people will face in the last days. We will find ourselves caught in the middle between loyalty to God and pressure from a world that wants us to conform. It will not be easy, but it presents a powerful opportunity. When someone is in the middle, both sides are watching and often listening more closely.

In His prayer in John 17, Jesus asked the Father not to take His followers out of the world but to keep them from its evil. We live here for a purpose, not to take sides in the world’s conflicts but to lift up Jesus, the only One who can draw every heart to Himself. He said, “And I, if I am lifted up from the earth, will draw all peoples to Myself.” John 12:32

Ellen White stated, “The last rays of merciful light, the last message of mercy to be given to the world, is a revelation of His character of love” (Christ’s Object Lessons, p. 415). Even when caught in the middle, may our lives reveal that love clearly, so the world can see Jesus.
