Pastor's Corner

This week, our hearts turn toward gratitude, but not the surface kind that lasts only as long as the leftovers. Scripture invites us into something deeper. In Revelation 14, the Three Angels carry a message that is often understood as a prophetic warning. Yet when you slow down and really listen, you find a surprising theme woven through it. It is Thanksgiving. Real thanksgiving. The kind that shapes a life, not just a holiday.

The first angel speaks of the everlasting gospel. That word everlasting reminds us that God's grace does not come and go like seasons. It is steady. It is sure. It is older than our problems and stronger than our fears. True gratitude begins there. Before we count blessings on our table, we remember the blessing that came from Calvary.

The second part of the message calls us to fear God, give Him glory, and worship the Creator. Gratitude grows roots when it becomes obedience. When we choose to live in a way that honors the One who made us, our thankfulness becomes visible. Sabbath becomes one of the clearest ways to say, every single week, Thank You, Lord, You hold my life.

The final picture is of people who endure with the faith of Jesus. They shine because they choose gratitude instead of complaint. They choose trust instead of fear. In a world growing darker, thankfulness becomes a light.

My prayer this week is simple. May your gratitude run deeper than a day on the calendar. May it become an identity shaped by the God who rescued you, created you, and walks with you through every season.
