Years ago, when I was in about 3rd grade, I attended a Methodist Sunday School. And my Sunday School teachers there encouraged me to ask my parents why they didn't go to Church or Sunday School. My dad did swing shifts, but he was awake when I asked him why he didn't go. What he told me was that the Methodists weren't even going to church on the right day. He said the Bible says we should go to church on Saturday. Well, that was my dad and he was always right, so I went back and told my teachers what he said the following week. That didn't set too well with them.

It wasn't until I was 19 that my dad started going to a Seventh-Day Adventist Church. While there he was given some Bible studies. He was a very wise father. Instead of filling out those studies himself, he had me do it. One of the pamphlets was on the Sabbath. After I looked up the Bible texts on that topic, I was totally convinced that the Adventists were right about Sabbath, so I went to their church the following week, and was baptized one week later.

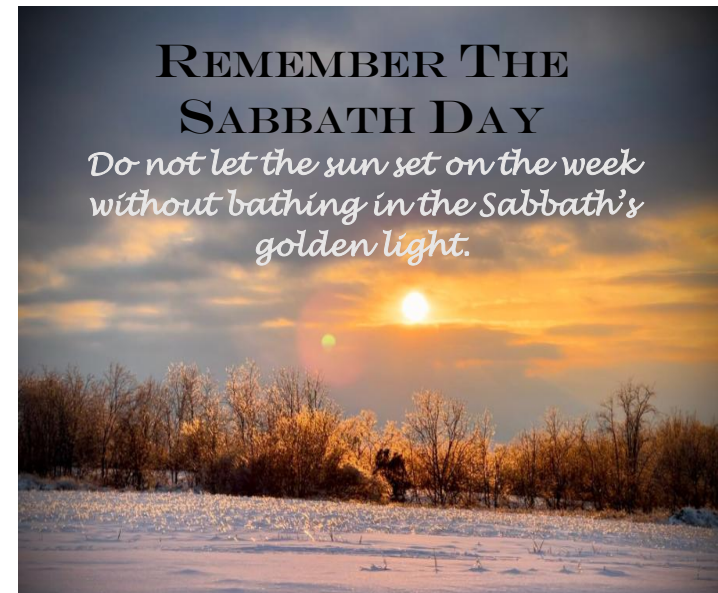
