### Pastor’s Corner:

There is something fascinating about how perspective can change everything.

Stand at the edge of a storm, and the sky appears dark, heavy, and threatening. But climb high enough above the clouds, and suddenly the same storm looks completely different. What seemed overwhelming from below becomes something passing beneath you.

Faith often works like that. There are moments in life when the world feels overwhelming. News cycles grow darker, conversations become harsher, and the quiet worries of the human heart start to build up like thunderclouds on the horizon. If we're not careful, we begin to believe that judgment, failure, and brokenness have the final say, but the gospel quietly tells a different story.

Scripture reminds us that God’s heart toward humanity is not indifference but astonishing compassion. The cross reveals something remarkable about the character of God. Justice is not ignored, yet mercy rises in a way that no human court could ever imagine.

That is why the apostle John can write, “*God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world, but to save the world through Him*” (John 3:17).

The Christian life is not lived under a sky permanently filled with thunder. It is lived in the surprising light that breaks through after the storm. And sometimes grace arrives in ways we never expected.

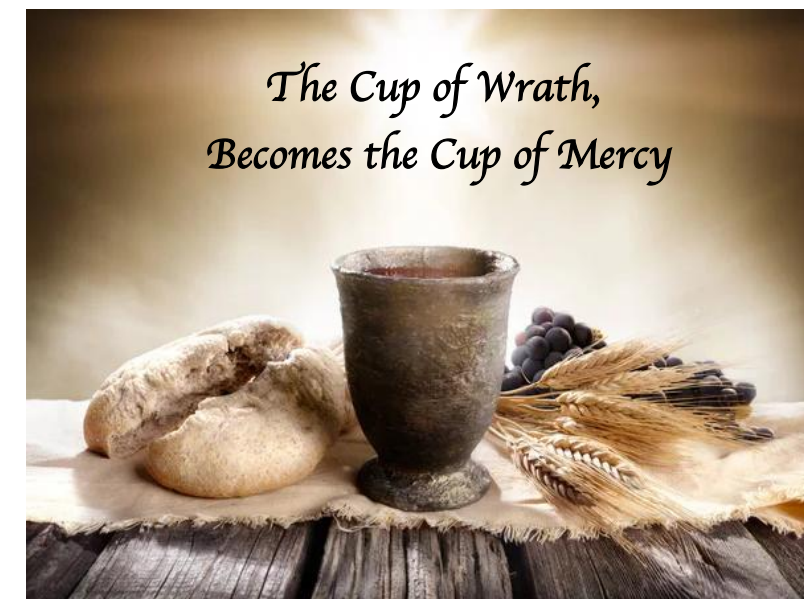
