### Pastor’s Corner:

There’s something strangely revealing about how we deal with things that stop working. When a phone glitches, we restart it. When a car makes noise, we turn the radio up just a little louder and hope for the best. And when life feels off, we often do the same, adjust a few habits, push a bit harder, and promise ourselves we’ll do better next week.

But every so often, you run into something that won’t respond to adjustment. No amount of tweaking, polishing, or determined effort can bring it back to life. It simply needs something deeper, something you can’t manufacture on your own.

Spiritually, we don’t always like admitting that. We prefer manageable problems, the kind we can fix with a bit of discipline and a stronger cup of coffee. Yet Scripture gently points us somewhere else. “Create in me a clean heart, O God” (Psalm 51:10). That’s not the language of self-improvement. That’s the language of surrender. And maybe that’s where grace quietly finds us, not at our strongest, but at our most honesty.

Because faith isn’t about becoming a slightly improved version of yourself. It’s about letting God do what you cannot do, to reshape what is at the very heart of who you are. Not rushed, not forced, but steady, patient, and often in ways you only see in hindsight.

So, as you move through this week, don’t just ask what needs to change around you. Take a quiet moment to consider what God might be doing within you.
