Our mission is to provide funds to wash and dry the clothes of individuals and families with little to no income in our community. We are so grateful to our generous donors and volunteers from our home church. Over the past 2.5 years, we have washed and dried 2,050 single loads of laundry for those facing hardships. In 2025 alone, we funded 1,237 loads, providing dignity and relief to those in need.
