"Which office do I go to, to get my reputation back"

Raymond J. Donovan was a successful New Jersey construction executive before becoming the US Secretary of Labor in the Ronald Reagan Administration in 1981. He faced intense scrutiny, false accusations, and indictments during his tenure, resigning in 1985 amid legal battles. He and his co-defendants were fully acquitted on all charges. Jurors reportedly stood and applauded upon rendering their verdict. The case had dragged on for years, costing Donovan personally and professionally. Even his legal victory could not restore his damaged public image, thus his question; "Which office do I go to, to get my reputation back."

Throughout history there have been thousands of people (including Jesus and his followers) whose lives have been ruined or even ended because of false accusations made and repeated until they are almost universally believed.

James 3:9 &10 says, "With our tongue we praise our Lord and Father, and with it we curse human beings, who have been made in God's likeness. Out of the same mouth come praise and cursing. My brothers and sisters, this should not be." Thou shalt not bear false witness against thy neighbor.

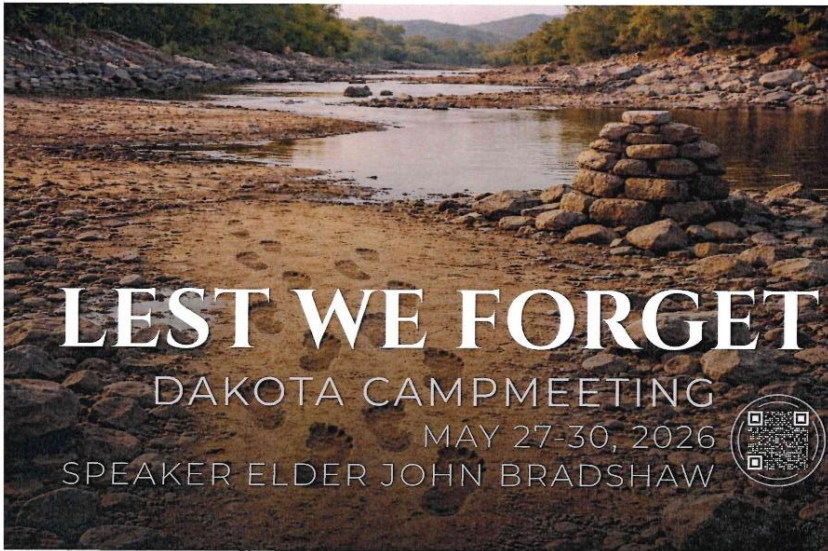
