Pastor’s Corner:

Hebrews 11:1-2 reminds us, *"Now faith is confidence in what we hope for and assurance about what we do not see."* This is what the people of old were commended for. In a world filled with uncertainties, our faith in God stands as the only unshakeable foundation. It’s through faith that we find strength and assurance, knowing that God’s promises are true even when they are not immediately visible.

The Bible repeatedly emphasizes the importance of faith. In 2 Corinthians 5:7, we are urged to *"walk by faith, not by sight."* This means trusting God's plan even when the path ahead is unclear. Similarly, Proverbs 3:5-6 advises, *"Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways submit to him, and he will make your paths straight."* These scriptures reassure us that faith is our guiding light through life’s uncertainties.

Ellen White reinforces this in her book *Steps to Christ*: *"It is faith that connects us with heaven and brings us strength for coping with the powers of darkness. In Christ, God has provided means for subduing every sinful trait, and resisting every temptation, however strong."* This quote encapsulates the essence of Hebrews 11:1-2, highlighting that our faith in God is not just a belief but a powerful force that sustains and empowers us. Friends, trusting in God’s promises allows us to face life's trials with unwavering confidence, knowing He is always with us. I to remind of an age-old quote from the pen of Ellen White *"We have nothing to fear for the future unless we forgot how God has led us in the past."*

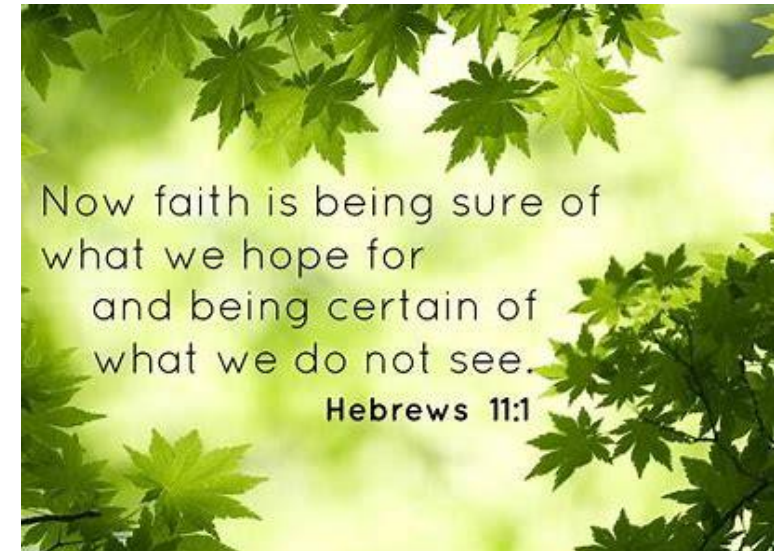
