Pastor's Corner: Dear Church Family,

A lot has happened since I have seen you. Camp meeting was a wonderful experience where many were blessed by the Christ centered presentations.

Elder Piotrowski came to our church board meeting on Tuesday, June 7, informing the board of developments and changes taking place in our Conference that will have an impact on our congregation. Also, the leadership of the Conference is busy with the realignment of districts. In short, this is how these changes and developments will impact our congregation.

- 1) Bismarck congregation will form a district with DAA.
- 2) An associate pastor will be assigned to this congregation. His workload will be divided on a 50/50 split between Bismarck and DAA.
- 3) I will continue to function as the senior pastor of Bismarck where most of my time will be spent. The associate pastor will function under my guidance and direction as this will help him in the further development of his pastoral skills.
- 4) I was recently elected as Ministerial Director of the Dakota Conference, which I accepted. What does this mean? It means that I become the pastor of the pastors in our Conference. Part of my assignment is to look after the pastors and their families, lending support to them in times of need.
- 5) I will continue to serve as the senior pastor of Bismarck Church but will spend at least one Sabbath of the month at another church in our Conference to visit with the pastor and congregation.
- 6) I will also be away maybe twice a year for about a week at a time attending meetings at the Union Offices. My schedule will be made available to the congregation so that you know my whereabouts, but most importantly, I will always be available to serve you as my first priority.

Unfortunately, my first assignment starts this week with the Called Convention in Lexington, Kentucky. This is a convention for the NAD pastors that takes place every 5 years. I will help facilitate meetings at this convention and, therefore, must be there earlier than the attendees. This means that I will return to Bismarck on June 26. You are welcome to call me any time you feel the need for prayer or help, or even just to say hello.
