**Communion Service:** On Sabbath, July 30<sup>th</sup> communion service will be held. All are invited to participate in the Lord's Supper.

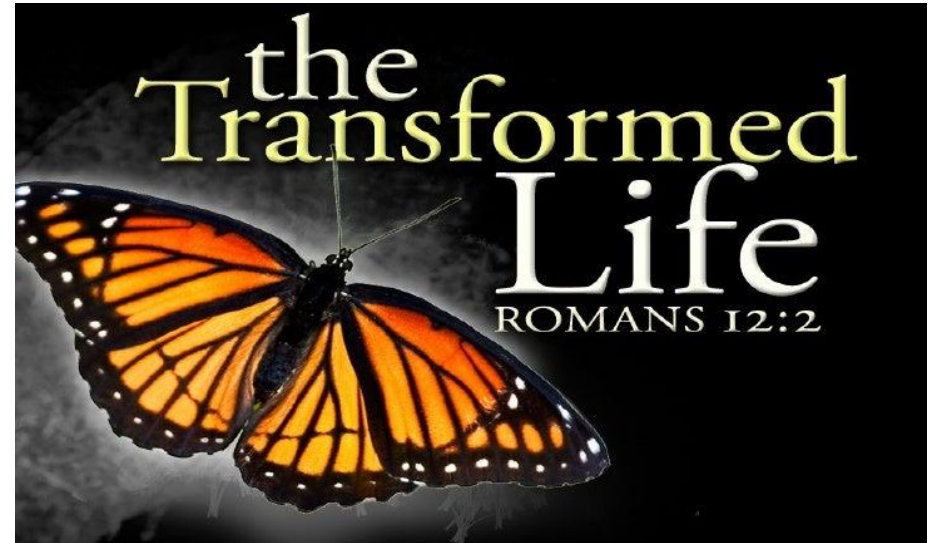

**Pastor’s Corner:** “Oh, sing to the Lord a new song! For He has done marvelous things,” (Psalm 98:1). Music has always been such a contention when you combine it with church worship. Many people struggle to find the right balance with music and worship with questions such as, “What is acceptable music in church?” We should rather ask, “What value does music bring to your worship experience?” In the book, Education, it tells us that the blessings are great in your response to songs of praise. *“How often in spiritual experience is the history repeated! How often by words of holy song are unsealed in the soul, the springs of penitence and faith, of hope and love and joy”* (Ed. 162). Song is for many a way to express their faith in God, they convey joyfully their adoration to their Savior. For Moses it was important to embody the commandments in sacred song so that one could learn the law verse by verse. Christian music should therefore not be seen as entertainment, but worshipfully learn more about God and His salvation for us. The book, Education, says the following, *“With a song, Jesus in His earthly life met temptation. Often when sharp stinging words were spoken, often when the atmosphere about Him was heavy with gloom, with dissatisfaction, distrust, or oppressive fear, was heard His song of faith and holy cheer”* (Ed. 166). As we partake in song may we follow the example of Christ our Savior.
