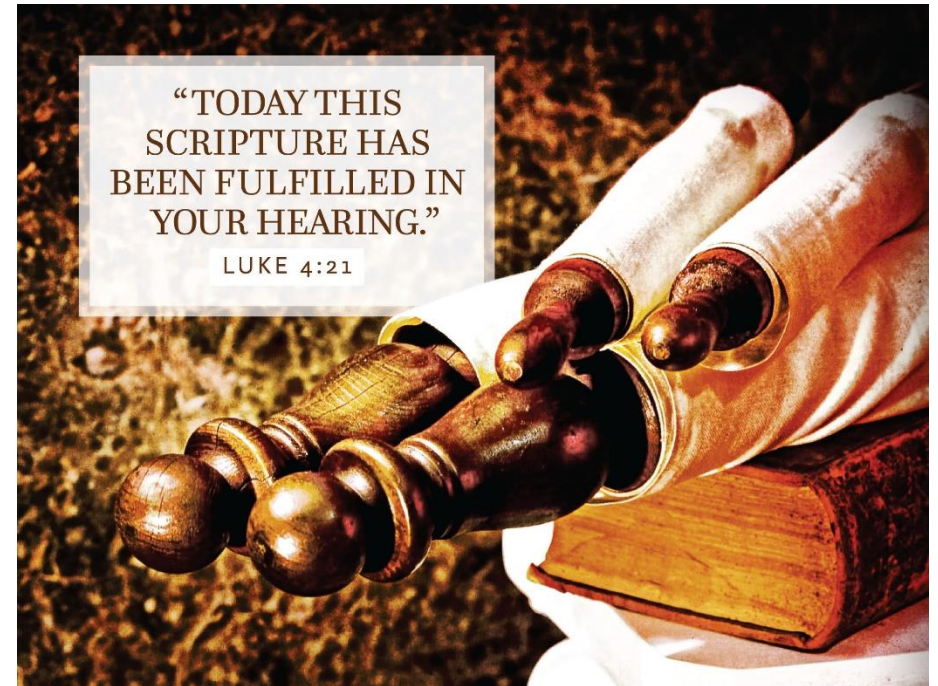

Witnesses are key figures to solve a crime or recount an incident to form an almost perfect visual of what happened in the past. Dear Church Member,

We are starting a new activity in DAA hoping that it will inspire kinship between our students at DAA and the members within your congregations. The students at DAA come from various backgrounds and they are affiliated with several different denominations. Here we have an opportunity to help all of our students experience a caring community of believers. This activity is primarily based around gift giving where families or individual church members can “support” a student at DAA and purchase a \$25 - \$35 gift for them. Here is how the activity works.

If you choose to participate in the activity, we will ask that you contact me and specify how many students you will commit to “support” in the gift exchange. We have a total of 35 students. The students have created individual wish lists with 3 items on them. They were advised to keep it simple and under \$35.

Members who choose to “support” a student for Christmas will be asked to purchase gifts for them from their wish list. They may send cards along with the gifts if they choose to make it more personal. We will ask that all members mail or send all the gifts to the school by December 5. The Christmas Party at DAA is on December 11, and staff are committed to buying some gifts if not all students are accounted for in the exchange.
