Pastor’s Corner:

We often say, “Nothing is impossible with God,” based on scriptures. Ellen G. White also wrote: “One thing is impossible with God (Letter 83, 1895).

Luke 1:37 reads “For with God nothing is impossible”, which declares His unlimited power. But did you know there is one thing even God cannot do? There might be more, but this one thing God cannot do.

Imagine a parent standing at the bedside of their critically ill child. The doctors have exhausted every option, and there’s only one possible way to save the child—a procedure that requires the parent to make a life-threatening sacrifice. Most parents wouldn’t hesitate. Love compels them to give all, even at great personal cost, for the life of their child.

This kind of sacrificial love points us to the heart of God. Yet, as immense as a parent’s love may be, it pales in comparison to God’s love for us—a love so profound that it reached its pinnacle in the giving of His only Son. We will explore this impossibility in today’s sermon, but keep in mind that this does not limit God at all, as a matter of fact it illuminates His Godly attributes!

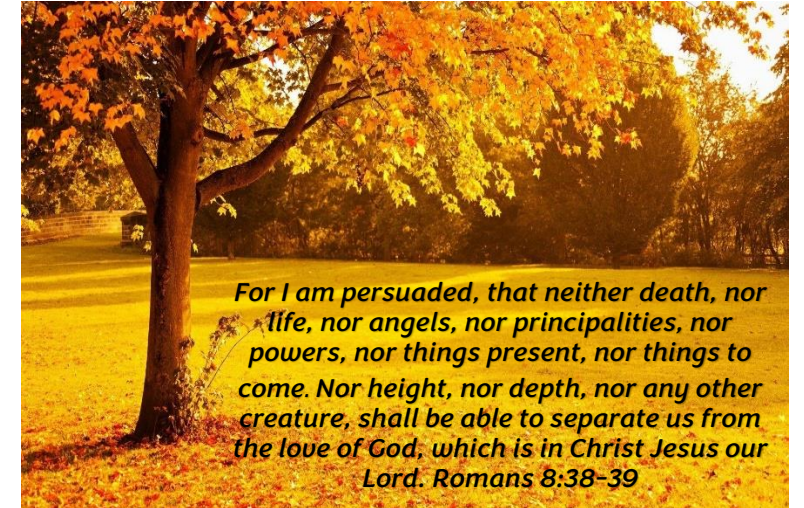
