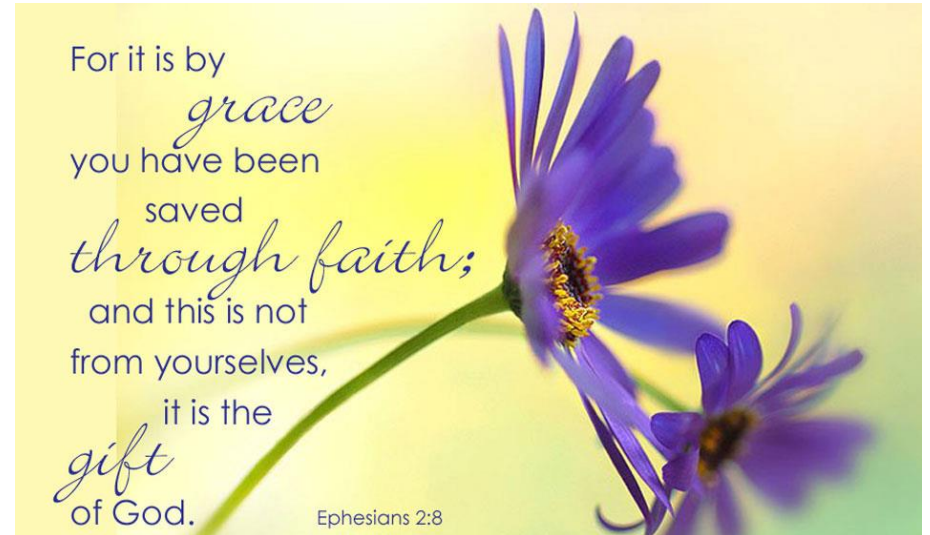

Black Hills Health & Education Center: There are announcements on the Bulletin Board of the Summer Series taking place at the Black Hills Health & Education Center.

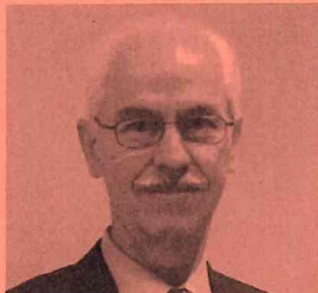
Fellowship Meal: You are welcome to the fellowship meal today. Please bring a vegetarian dish to share.
