Pastor’s Corner: How would you most like to be remembered? As we are exiting the Christmas Season, all the characters of the Christmas story are still fresh on our minds. Mary, Joseph, Baby Jesus, the shepherds and of course the wise men are familiar to us. Even though we don’t know the wise men’s names we know they were wise; that is how they will always be remembered. They were men who obeyed and followed the star to Jesus, our King. In 2 Samuel 14 the Bible also speaks of a very wise woman, unnamed; simply called the wise woman of Tekoah. She did not follow a star, but she did follow instructions and go before King David. She wisely showed King David the importance of forgiving Absalom, who had been banished from the country and from David’s life. In Verse 14 she reminds David of God’s love for His children. *“For we will surely die, and become like water spilt on the ground, which cannot be gathered up again. Yet God does not take away life, but He devises means, so that his banished ones are not expelled from him”*. King David heeded the advice of the wise woman and was eventually reunited with his son Absalom. In Verse 33: *“And when he had called for Absalom, he came to the king, and bowed himself on his face to the ground before the king: and the king kissed Absalom”*. God loves us so much. He devised a plan that we would not be banished from our Father’s presence. I pray we are each remembered as those who loved God and wisely brought unity where there once was division.
