**Prayers for Bob Hieb:** Please keep Bob in your prayers as Bob slipped on the ice and broke his hip. He had surgery yesterday.

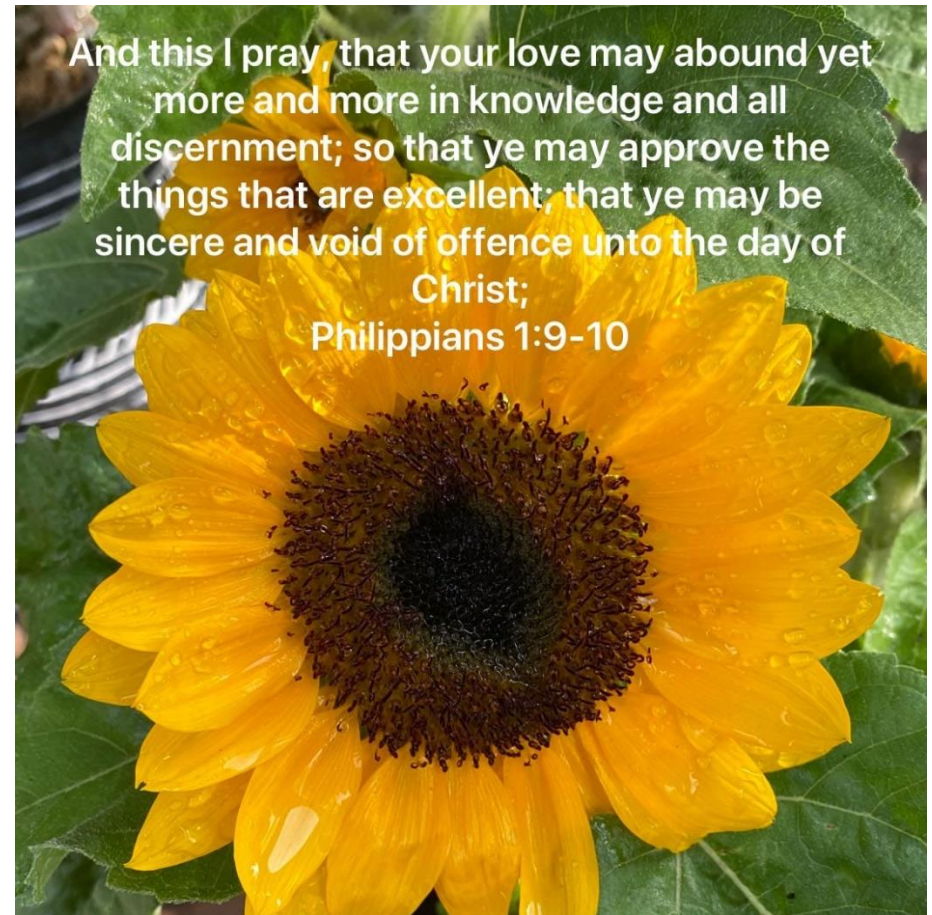
