Brentwood School Board Meeting: The board meeting will be Monday, February 22nd at 6:30 pm.

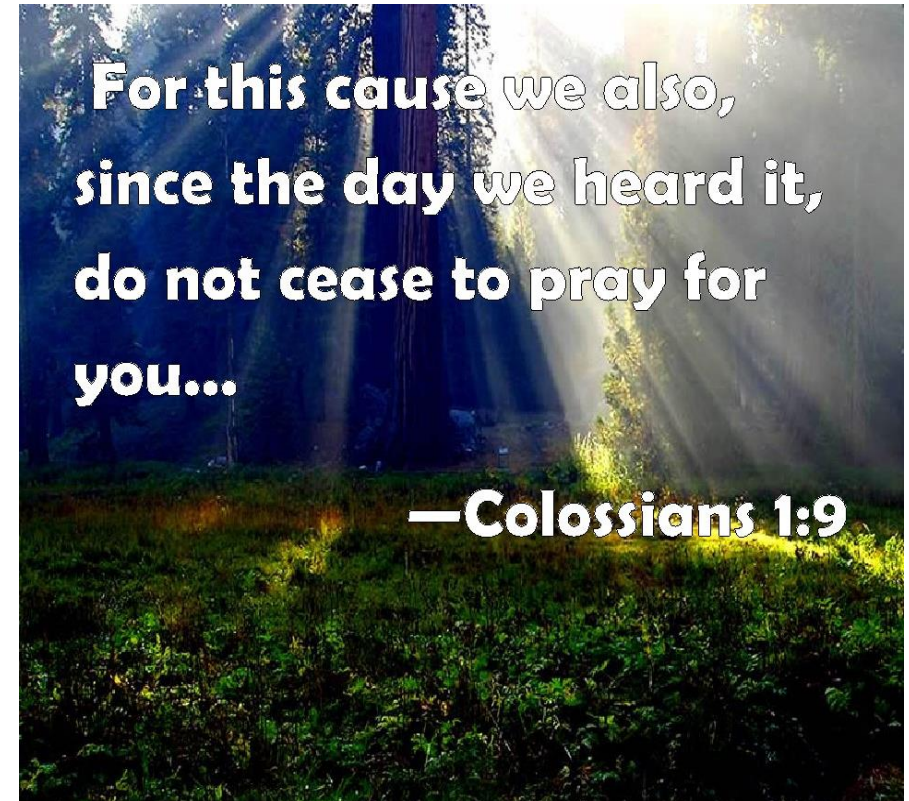

God's Word is jammed pack full of promises that God has made to us which give us hope to keep on going even when someone hurts us by breaking a promise. God does not break promises. He keeps His Word always. When we hold on to His promises, we have the strength and the courage not to be stalled by fear of failure. In Isaiah 26:3-4 we find a great promise, *"You will keep him in perfect peace, whose mind is stayed on You, because he trusts in You. Trust ye in the LORD forever, for in the LORD JEHOVAH is everlasting strength."* Perfect peace, now that is a great promise and something I am sure we all long for.
