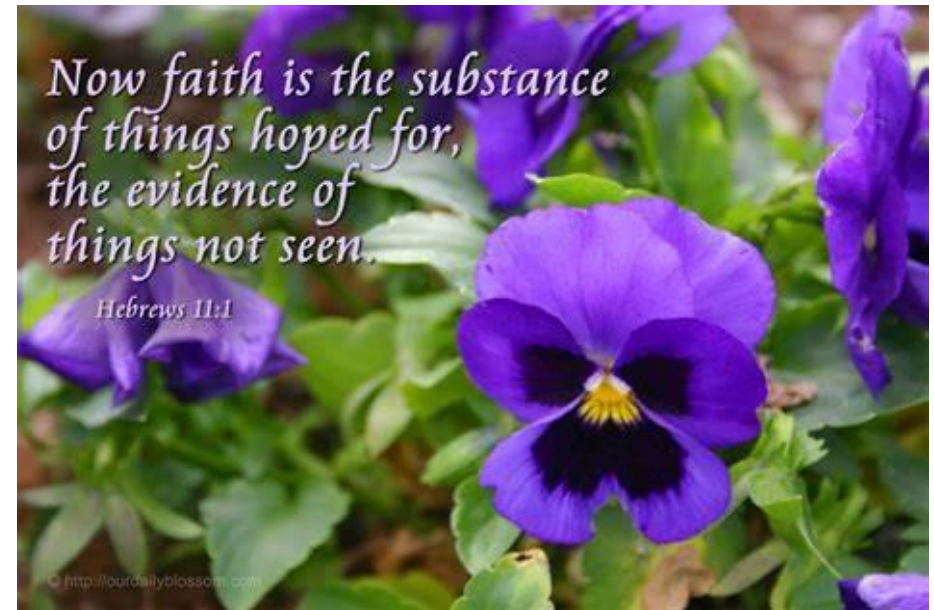
Fellowship Meal: You are welcome to the fellowship meal today. Please bring a vegetarian dish to share.

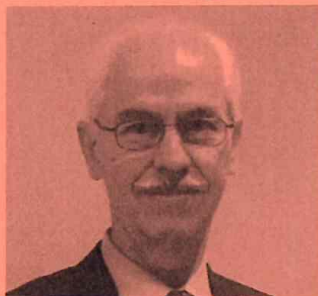
