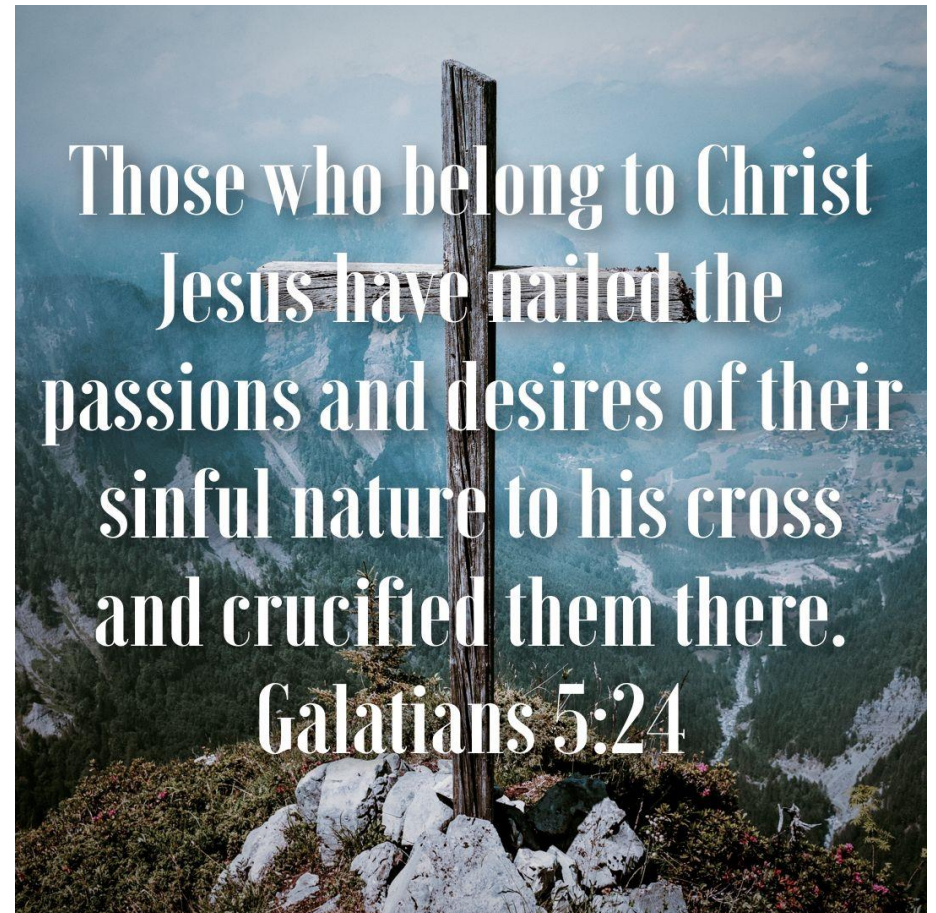
Youth Emphasis Day: April 2nd Pastor Vernon will be directing his message to the youth.

Pastor’s Corner: Because English is not my first language, I thought about the difference in being resentful and holding a grudge. I knew neither one was good but couldn’t really identify the difference. I thought of resentful as being just a feeling you have for someone which causes you to have a lot of regret of circumstances in your life that you feel that person has caused. Even so, you don’t go to them and tell them what you feel. On the other hand, I felt a grudge was a feeling of holding something against a person and exhibiting anger openly to the person because of what they had done to you. Yes, I was wrong. Resentful is to feel or show displeasure or indignation from a sense of injury or insult. A grudge is a *feeling* of ill will. Even though I had the two words confused, I was right in knowing neither one is good to have in your life. In Matthew 5 Jesus has this to say about grudges. *“This is how I want you to conduct yourself in these matters. If you enter your place of worship and are about to make an offering, you suddenly remember [something] a grudge a friend has against you, abandon your offering, leave immediately, go to this friend, and make things right. Then come back and work things out with God”*. You got grudges, feel resentment towards someone? Go and make things right with them. Then you will be free to worship God in Spirit and Truth. He is so much more than a feeling. He is mighty to save, heal, and deliver. *“For I am the LORD that healeth thee.”* He heals of all things, even grudges and resentment.
