Pastor’s Corner:

It is evident that all the gospels and Pauline letters point to belief in God as the key ingredient to salvation. However, it is difficult to know what to do with the salvation we claim. Is there a biblical response that begs our immediate attention?

In Paul’s first letter to Corinth, he illustrates how every part of life can be seen through the gospel once it is accepted. The Corinthian Christians, even after accepting Christ as their savior, struggled with division, indecent relationships, diet, proper worship, and a disbelief in the resurrection. In response, Paul explains that unity can be found in focusing on Jesus, freedom in Christ should not lead to more brokenness in relationships, eating food sacrificed to idols is permissible but should not distract others, every person has a part in honoring God, and the resurrection is crucial in understanding the purpose for which Christ came.

When the gospel is the focus of one’s attention, all actions should be an outpouring of Christ’s two greatest commandments: love God and love your neighbor. Paul understood that such a phrase might confuse his audience. So, he wrote 1 Corinthians 13 to help them understand how selfless love is manifested in community.

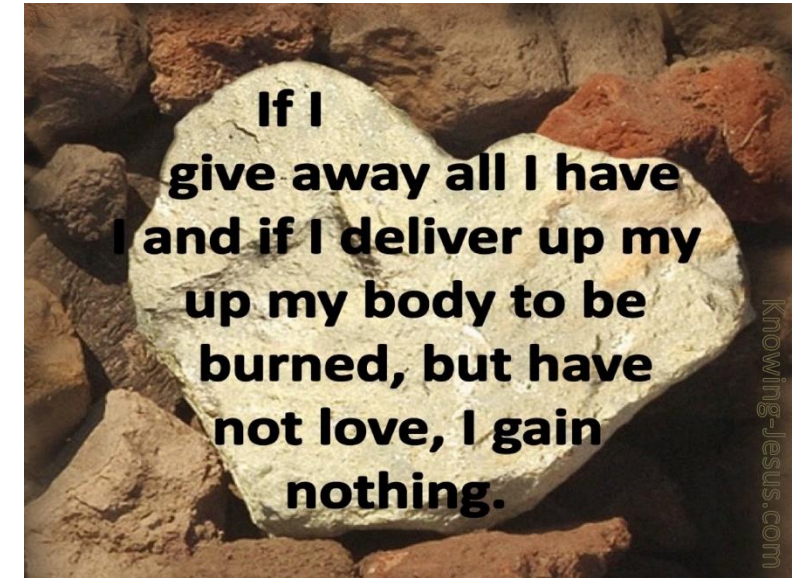
