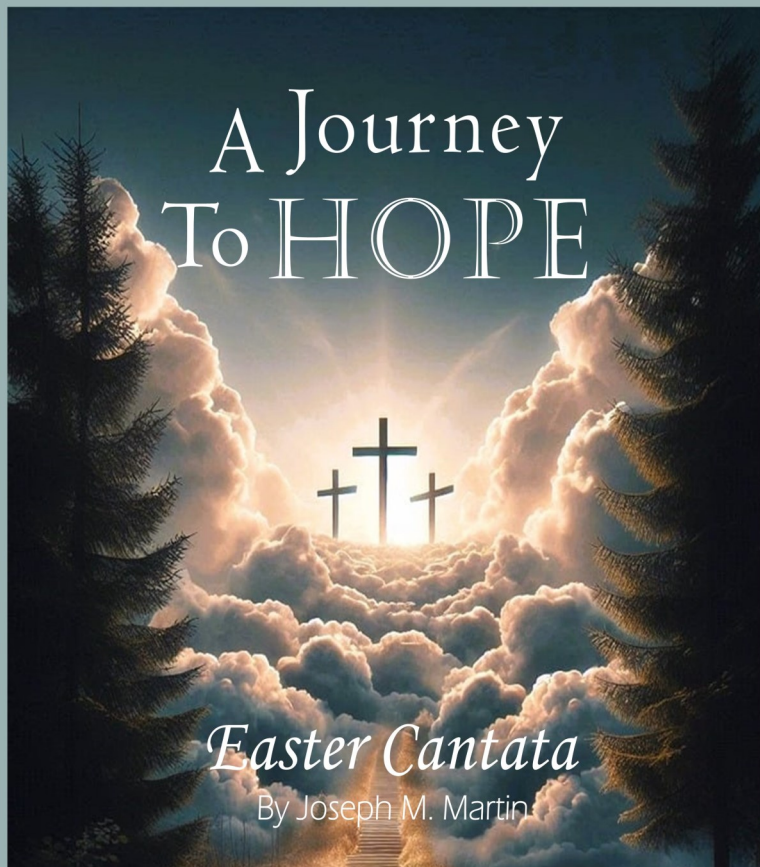

### ADVENTURER FAMILY FUN DAY (TRI-CITIES, WA) — APRIL 27

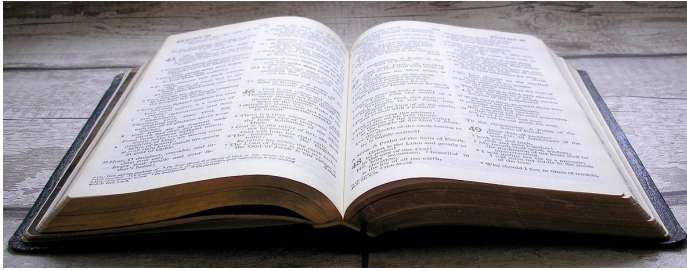
