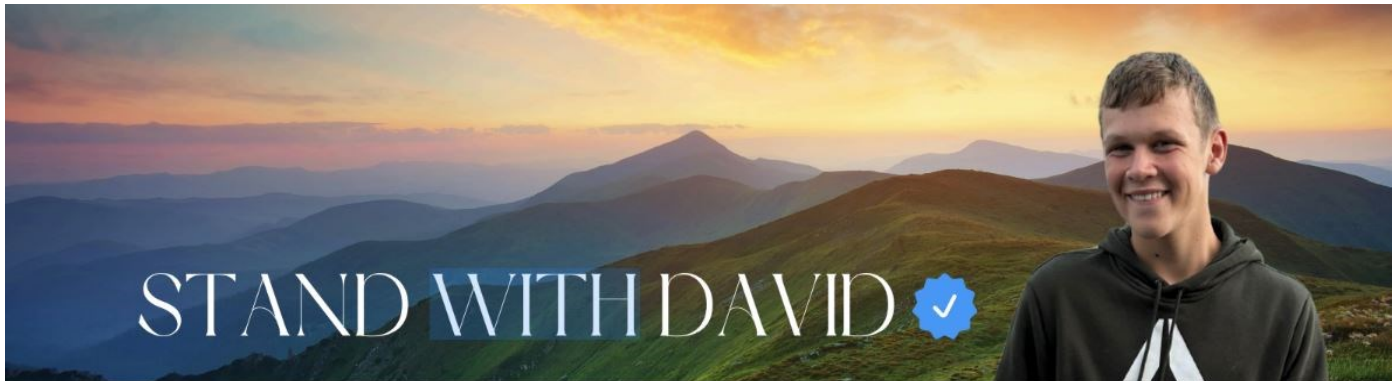

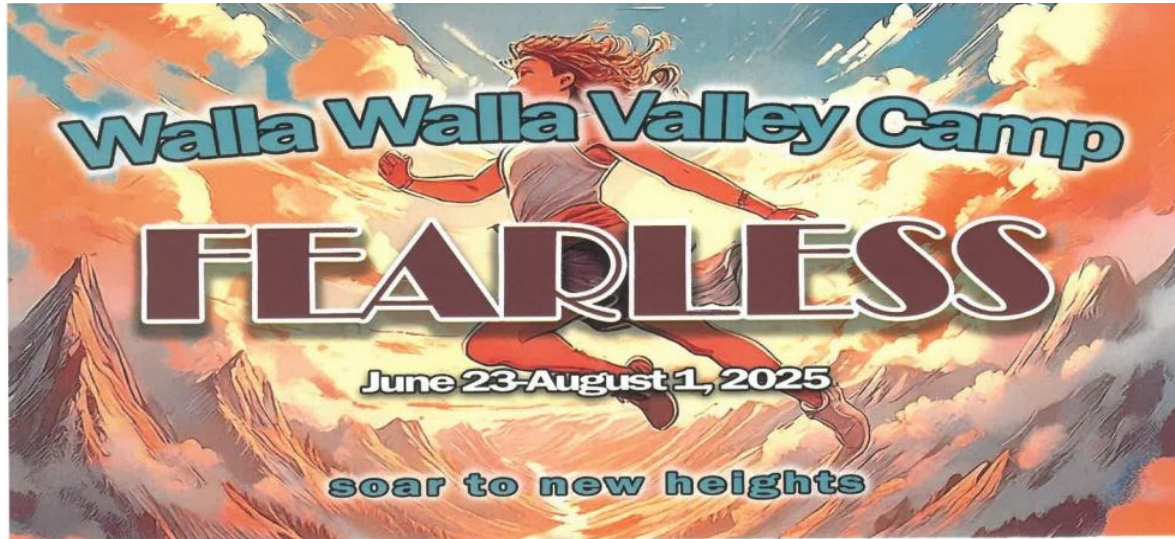

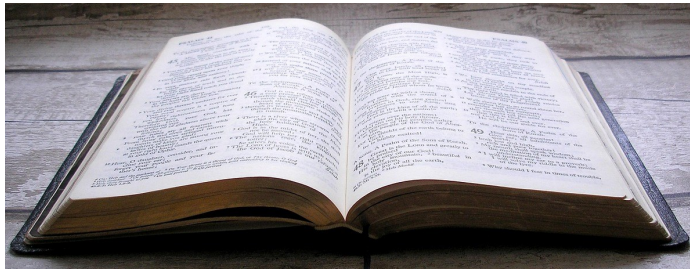
A CLARION CALL TO PRAYER: FOR SUCH A TIME AS THIS
