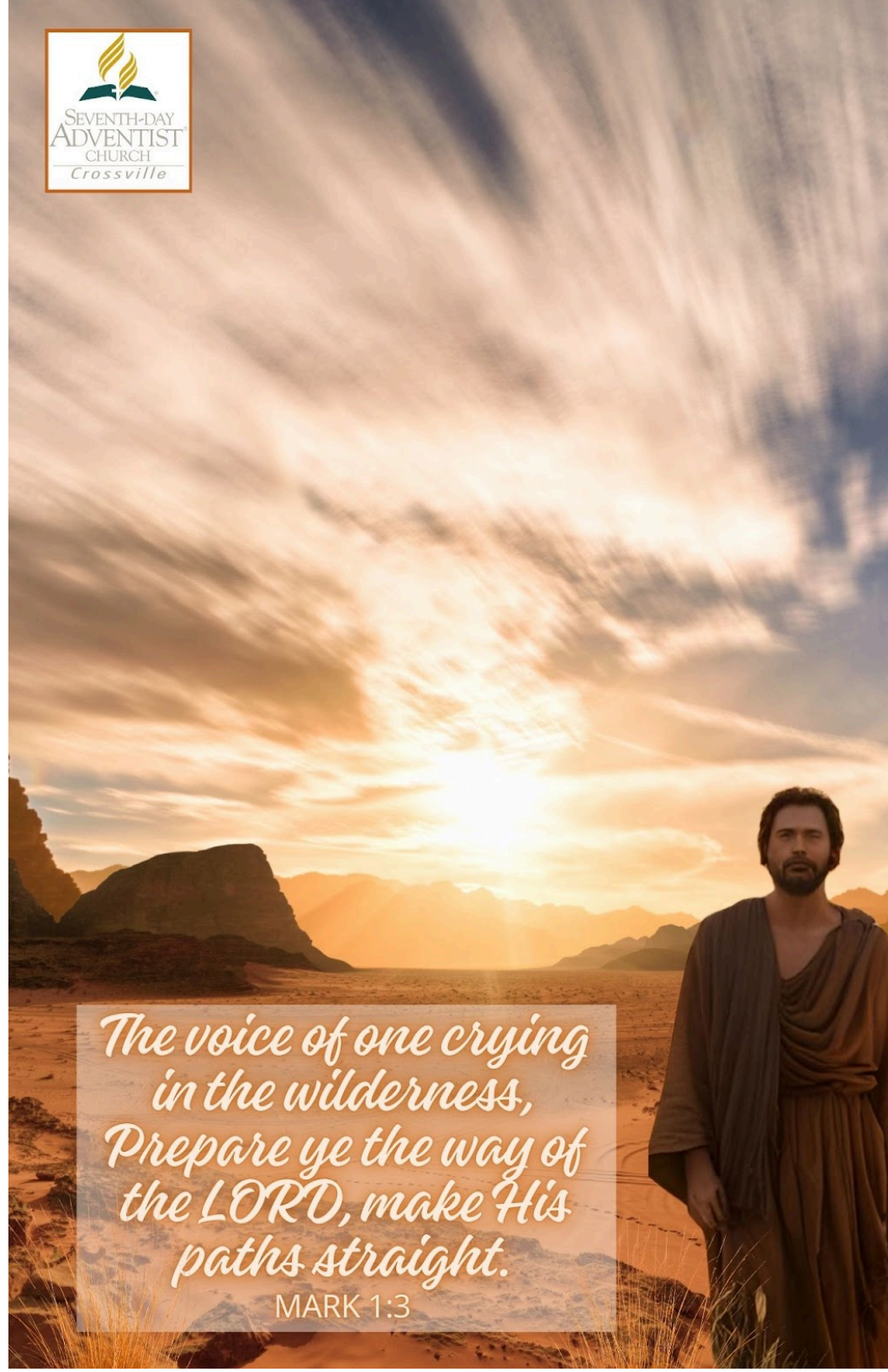

4 qts. water  
 1 c. diced carrots  
 2 large onions, chopped  
 1 c. diced celery (2 c.)  
 3 stalks leek, sliced  
 1 cup cubed potatoes  
 1/2 pkg. frozen peas or lima beans  
 cans (1 lb. 3oz each)  
 sp. salt  
 1/2 c. chopped parsley
