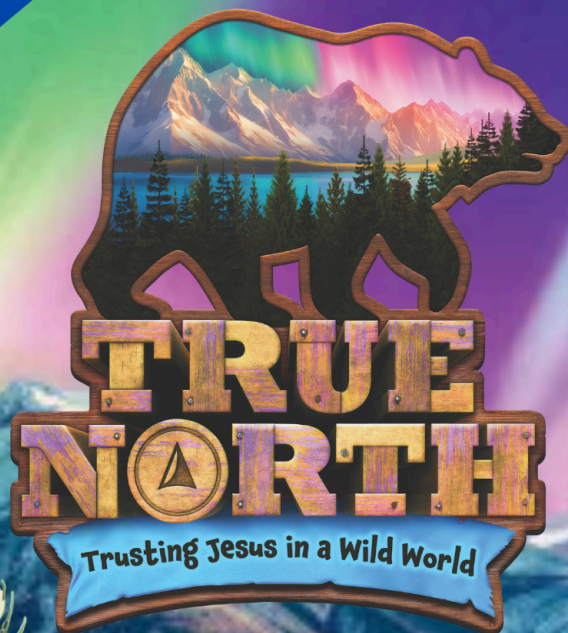

- We could also use more newspapers this year if you have any extras to share.

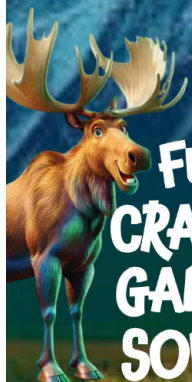
