## Did You Know?

- 1) Less than 10% of 'born again' Christian homes ever open the Bible during a given week or pray together other than at meal times.

## Quilter

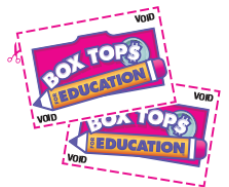

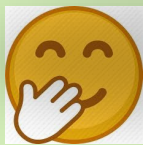
