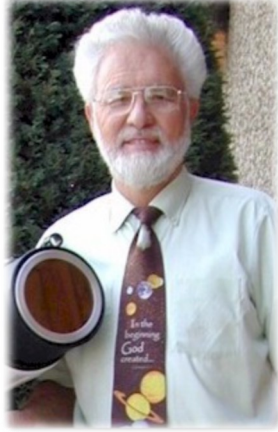

Best age: the age of accountability

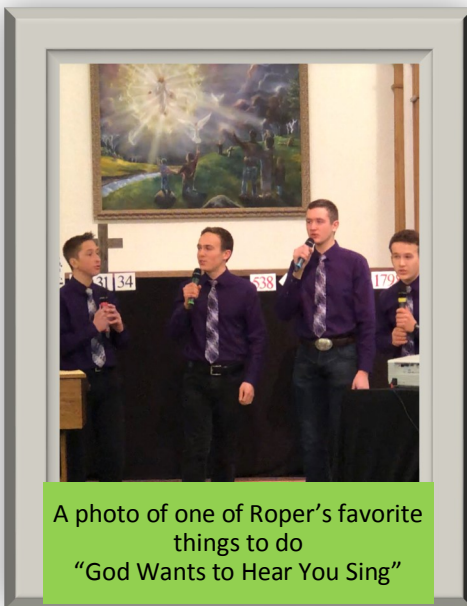
One of the most interesting people from history: Abraham

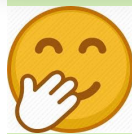
