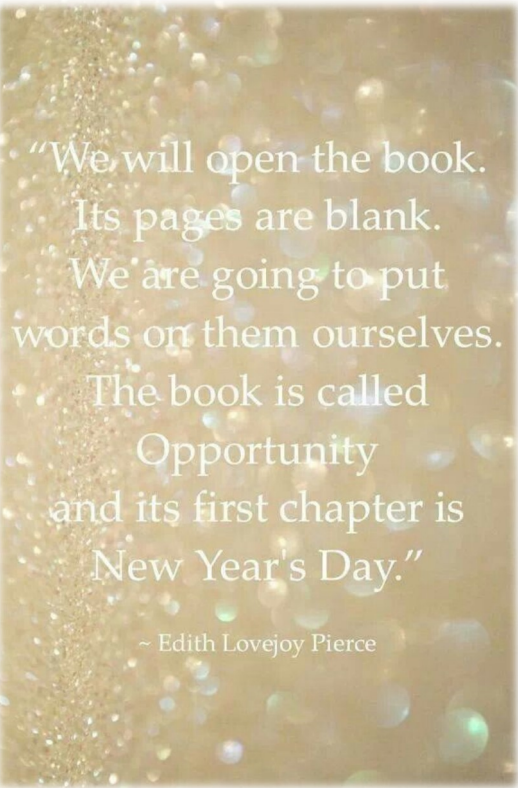

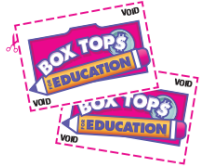


## School Portraits
