Birthday, graduation, or one of many get togethers? Rent one of the park pavilions at Veterans or Elizabeth Park. Picnic Tables, Electricity (Veterans Only), Grill, Food Table, Playground Equipment is all available.

Village Residents & Non-Residents: will pay a \$25.00 Deposit which is refundable after the park areas are cleaned up and if there is no damage to the pavilion. Non-Residents: will also be charged a \$50.00 Rental Fee

The parks cannot be reserved by non-residents before 90 days of their event.
