As the weather is getting nicer, please remember to be a good neighbor! When mowing your lawn or weed trimming be kind and make sure the debris is blowing back into your yard and not your neighbors! Also, please to not blow grass clippings and debris into the roadway as this can make driving conditions dangerous if it rains and they become wet and very slippery. This is especially dangerous for motorcycles. Also, a gentle reminder that water on your property should stay on your property.

Please Do Not Flush Products such as baby-wipes, Clorox cleaning wipes, disposable diapers, tampons or tampon applicators down the toilet. This can cause damage to the wastewater system's lift stations and treatment facility. It can also cause problems with your plumbing and end up costing everyone in the end.



- **Flushing of Village Hydrants will be Monday and Tuesday, May 22nd & 23rd, 2023**

Flushing will be done overnight, beginning at 10:00 PM. By changing the time and the way we will be doing the hydrant flushing we are hoping to clear up some of the discoloration of the water. However, if you happen to notice a lot of discoloration it will help if you open your outside faucet and let it run to clear any debris.
