Over a period of time, it can cause damage to your pipes and also the Village Sewage. Charleston S.C. water system currently has the first-class action lawsuit against Kimberly-Clark Flushable & nonflushable due to damage of their community.

FYI

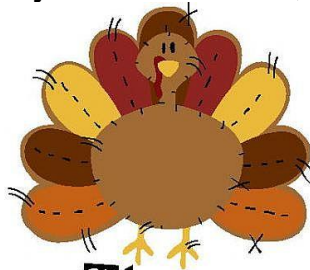
