We are also set up to accept credit card payments with a 3% convenience fee through Point & Pay.

Reservations for Village Park Pavilions

Birthday, graduation, or one of many get togethers? Rent one of the park pavilions at Veterans or Elizabeth Park. Picnic Tables, Electricity (Veterans Only), Grill, Food Table, Playground Equipment is all available.

Village Residents & Non-Residents: will pay a \$25.00 Deposit which is refundable after the park areas are cleaned up and if there is no damage to the pavilion. Non-Residents: will also be charged a \$50.00 Rental Fee

The parks cannot be reserved by non-residents before 90 days of their event.

For Burn Permits

Burn Permits can be obtained by calling the Township Office between the hours of 9am- 3:30 pm. During favorable weather, Permits can be issued up to 4 days.

Burn Permits: Burn Permits are required whenever you are burning on open ground - not in a fire pit. Burn permits are only issued for the burning of brush, grass and leaves. It is against the law to burn construction materials, demolition materials, plastic, old furniture, etc. Household garbage may be burned if contained in a barrel.

Burn Permits can be obtained by calling the Township Office between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. During favorable weather, permits can be issued up to four days. Please remember that the Township Office is closed Friday-Sunday. Plan ahead and get a permit number before 3:30 p.m. on Thursday

Please continue to save can tabs for new playground equipment. We have one full box so far. You can save these tabs and just drop them at the door. Thank you in advance.
