**We order only from top quality tree nurseries. Because of weather and other factors our liability for the viability of plant material ceases when plants are picked up, or left beyond the pickup date. We do the best we can to fulfill orders but sometimes we do hear from the nursery that they cannot get us what we pre-ordered last summer/fall. If this happens you will be notified.
