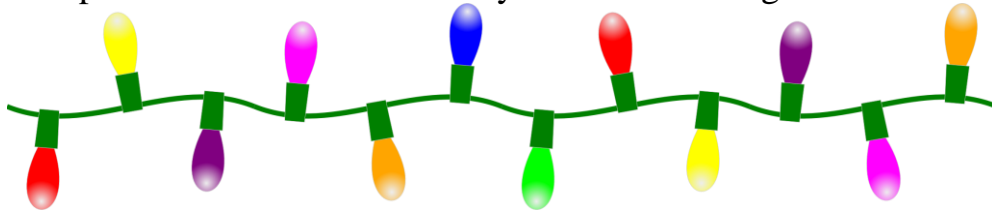
**Forms can also be picked up and filled out at the Village Hall. We will get them to the Fire Department for you.**
