As the weather is getting nicer, please remember to be a good neighbor! When mowing your lawn or weed trimming be kind and make sure the debris is blowing back into your yard and not your neighbors! Also, please do not blow grass clippings and debris into the roadway as this can make driving conditions dangerous if it rains and they become wet and very slippery. This is especially dangerous for motorcycles. Public Works will pick up small branches & limbs that are bundled and placed at the road. However, they will not pick-up whole trees. Our dump is too small for whole trees and is limited to unbagged leaves, grass & small branches. Please no building materials, and no sod.
