## **Focus on God's Amazing Creatures**

Take a few moments to be inspired by the amazing animals God brought to life on the fifth and sixth days of Creation. Here are some unusual facts about a few of the intricate creatures designed by our infinitely creative God.

• The Pistol Shrimp can snap its claw so fast

that it creates a sonic blast louder than a Concorde plane's sonic boom. The heat from the shrimp's sonic blast generates a high temperature



in the water, stunning or killing its prey.

• The Alpine Swift of W. Africa is able to stay

airborne for over 6 months without ever touching down. It holds the record for the longest uninterrupted flight by a bird, with over 200 days in



the air. It eats, drinks, and sleeps while flying.

Echidnas, also known as the "spiny anteater",

are small (30-45 cm) mammals who have a beak, sharp spikes, a kangaroo-like pouch, and lay eggs. After the tiny egg is laid it is transferred into



the mother's pouch where it then hatches.

 Koalas have fingerprints almost identical to a human's.



## Church Music Notes

## **Camp Meeting Hymns**

Many of the old gospel hymns of the church are sung at camp meeting time and call to mind the dedication of gospel hymn-writers of the previous centuries. Two of our hymns today are by one of the most prolific hymn writers of all time, Fanny Crosby, who wrote over 8,000 Christian hymns despite the handicap she struggled with during her life.



An inept doctor left Fanny without her eyesight at six weeks of age after a botched procedure. She said, "If perfect earthly sight were offered me tomorrow I would not accept it. I might not have sung hymns to the praise of God if I had been distracted by the beautiful and interesting things about me." All The Way My Savior Leads Me is one of her songwriting masterpieces.

This beloved hymn came to Fanny as a result of a prayer. Struggling financially, she desperately needed some money. As her usual custom, Fanny began to pray. A few minutes later, a gentleman offered her five dollars, the exact amount she needed. Later recalling the incident, she said, "I have no way of accounting for this except to believe that God put it into the heart of this good man to bring the money." The poem she wrote afterward became "All The Way My Savior Leads Me."

The title of the hymn *Redeemed,* Hymn 337, implies the idea of a slave standing on the trader's auction block being offered to the highest bidder. At last the price is paid by a compassionate new owner, who then gives the slave his unconditional freedom. But the freed slave, out of gratitude to his new owner, offers himself as a loving bond servant for life to his redeemer.

Man has been separated from God by sin and has become a slave of Satan. But man has been redeemed. Because Christ paid the ransom we owed to divine justice, we have been freed from the shackles of sin's bondage and eternal separation from God. Out of gratitude for this deliverance, we cling to our new master and lovingly determine to serve Him forever. A realization of redemption causes the ransomed to sing repeatedly, "Redeemed--, how I love to proclaim it, redeemed by the blood of the Lamb. . . ."

This popular gospel song is also by Fanny Crosby and first appeared with William Kirkpatrick's jubilant tune in the hymnal Songs of Redeeming Love, published in 1882.

The song begins, "Redeemed--how I love to proclaim it! Redeemed by the blood of the Lamb; redeemed thru. His infinite mercy--His child, and forever, I am."



One of the strongest evidences for the validity of the gospel is a redeemed, vibrant life. As both a songwriter and a woman of faith, Fanny Crosby serves as an example to all.
