Summary of Our Beliefs

1. We believe in God the Father, in His Son Jesus Christ, and in the Holy Spirit.
2. We believe in the death of Jesus Christ on Calvary as the atoning sacrifice for the sins of men, and that through faith in His shed blood men are saved from sin and its penalty.
3. We believe that Jesus Christ is our personal Savior, and God, for Christ's sake, has forgiven our sins and gives those who accept it, a new heart.
4. We accept by faith the righteousness of Christ, recognizing Him as our Intercessor in the heavenly sanctuary, and we are to claim His promise to strengthen us by His indwelling Spirit, so that we may receive power to do His will.
5. We believe that the Bible is God's inspired word, and that it constitutes the only rule of faith and practice for the Christian.
6. We believe the Ten Commandments are still binding upon Christians; and it is our purpose, by the power of the indwelling Christ, to keep this law, including the fourth commandment, which requires the observance of the seventh day of the week as the Sabbath of the Lord.
7. We believe in the soon coming of Jesus, and we determine to be personally ready to meet the Lord, and to do all in our power to witness to His loving salvation, and by life and word to help others to be ready for His glorious appearing.
