LIVESTREAMING

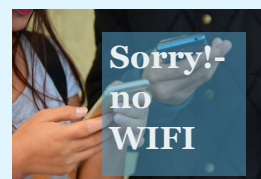
The evening meetings and Sabbath morning including Sabbath School, will be livestreamed.

Come explore how God is working through these ministries and find ways that you can minister, too!

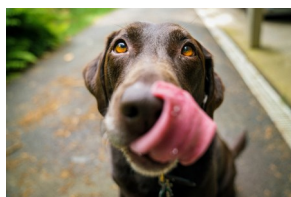

Registration is open to everyone beginning Friday, June 14. You can select the room or RV spot you want for 2025 camp meeting.

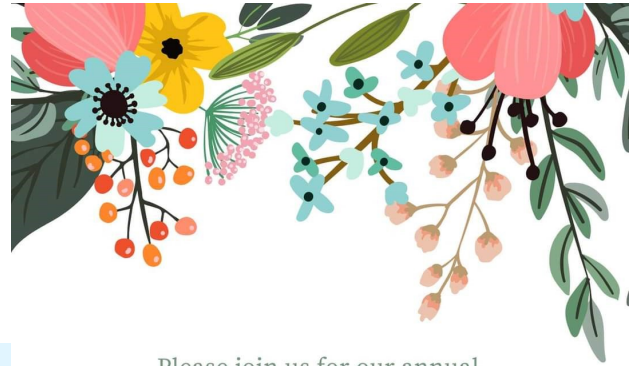
\$20 deposit required with request. Rooms and RV sites will be assigned after Camp Meeting in the order they were received (applies to reservations made during open registration).

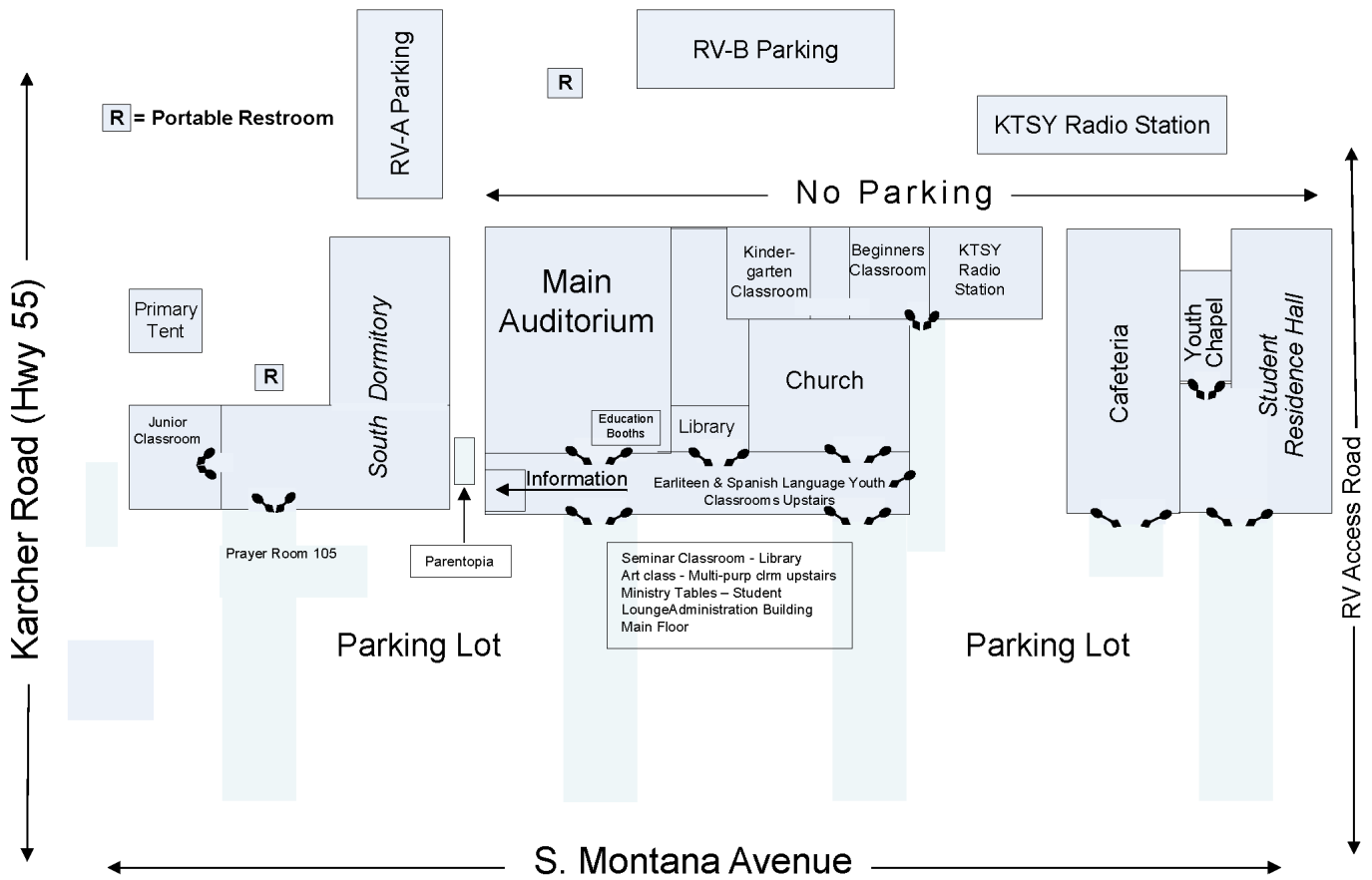
Please Note

4. For Beginners, children need to have a parent or adult guardian with them at all times. It would be ideal to have one adult for every child.
