School started on August 20, with an enrollment of sixteen students.

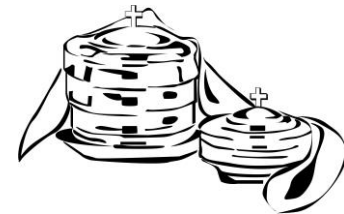

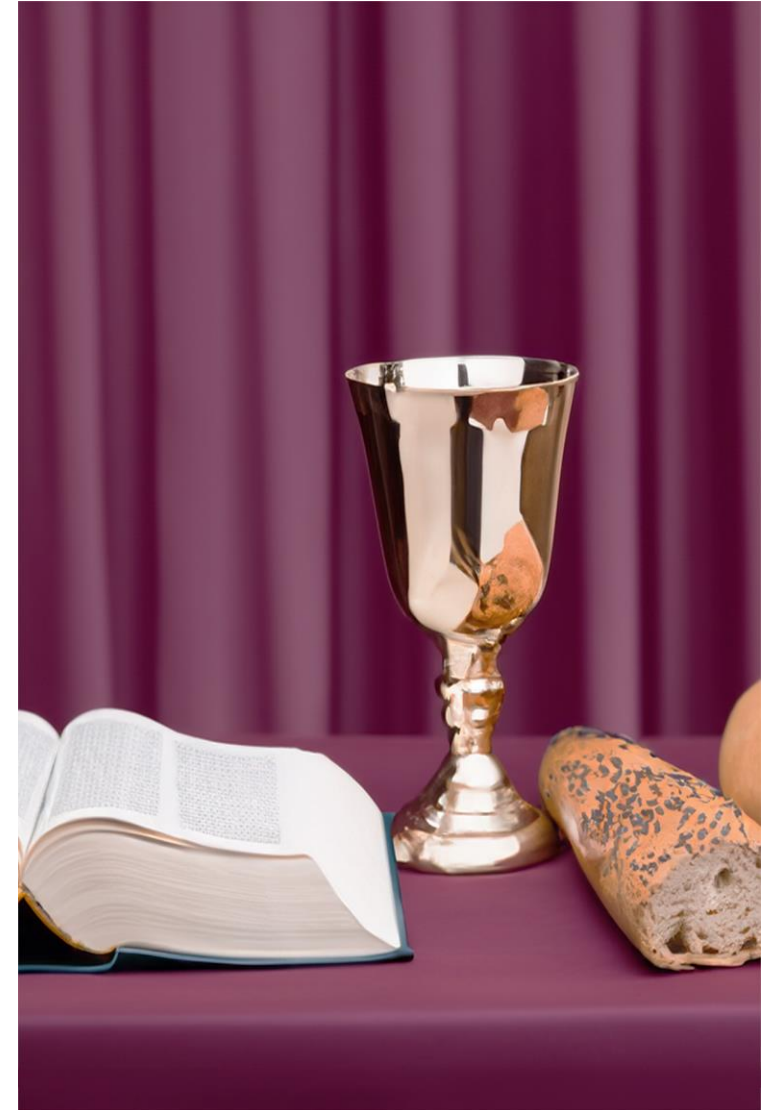
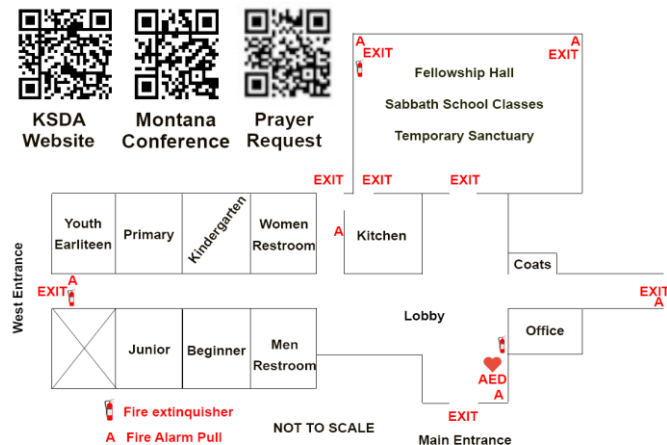
