CLASSROOM CORNER: Did You Know...?

VACS is having their annual Fall Festival on October 26 from 6:00 to 10:00 pm! Home and School Leader, Jennifer Chuey, has gone all out planning fun activities for everyone. There will be the traditional hayride, games, prizes, and a bake sale with the funds going towards school projects. But that isn’t all! **COOKS** share your skills by entering the Chili Cook Off or the Pie Contest! (Or both!) The Fall Festival Fund Raiser will help fund two VACS projects. 1) The first need is an automated external defibrillator (AED). It is estimated that every year 350,000 people die from a sudden cardiac arrest (SCA) in the United States. For every minute delay “restarting” the heart, the chances of survival drop by 7 to 10%. 2) We would like to invite pastor/teacher Bradley Booth, author of *Dare to Stand Alone* and *Shepherd Warrior*, to speak for our Week of Prayer in March. Both books are part of our SDA Bible and reading curriculums. His cost is \$500 and would also be a great opportunity for our students to meet an author of books they have read.

Did you know that we are completing our Organism Traits science standard? The lower grades have been learning all about inherited traits and how some changes are directly related to their environment. 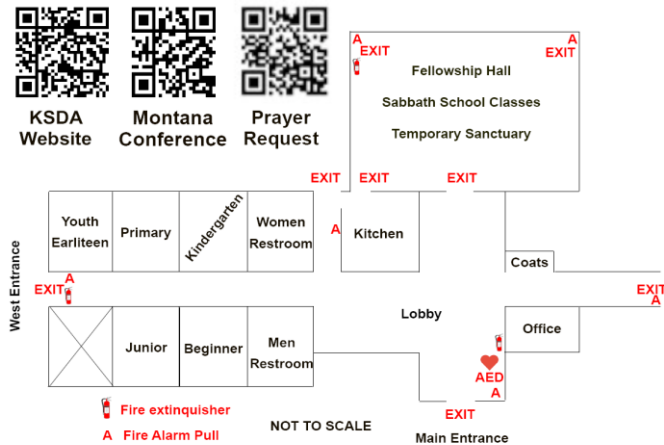
