## TODAY'S SCRIPTURE READING

2 Kings 22:1-5, 8-11

### KING JAMES VERSION

<sup>1</sup>Josiah was eight years old when he began to reign, and he reigned thirty and one years in Jerusalem. And his mother's name was Jedidah, the daughter of Adaiah of Boscath. <sup>2</sup>And he did that which was right in the sight of the Lord, and walked in all the way of David his father, and turned not aside to the right hand or to the left. <sup>3</sup>And it came to pass in the eighteenth year of king Josiah, that the king sent Shaphan the son of Azaliah, the son of Meshullam, the scribe, to the house of the Lord, saying, <sup>4</sup>Go up to Hilkiyah the high priest, that he may sum the silver which is brought into the house of the Lord, which the keepers of the door have gathered of the people: <sup>5</sup>And let them deliver it into the hand of the doers of the work, that have the oversight of the house of the Lord: and let them give it to the doers of the work which is in the house of the Lord, to repair the breaches of the house,....

<sup>8</sup>And Hilkiyah the high priest said unto Shaphan the scribe, I have found the book of the law in the house of the Lord. And Hilkiyah gave the book to Shaphan, and he read it. <sup>9</sup>And Shaphan the scribe came to the king, and brought the king word again, and said, Thy servants have gathered the money that was found in the house, and have delivered it into the hand of them that do the work, that have the oversight of the house of the Lord. <sup>10</sup>And Shaphan the scribe shewed the king, saying, Hilkiyah the priest hath delivered me a book. And Shaphan read it before the king. <sup>11</sup>And it came to pass, when the king had heard the words of the book of the law, that he rent his clothes.

### NEW LIVING TRANSLATION

<sup>1</sup>Josiah was eight years old when he became king, and he reigned in Jerusalem thirty-one years. His mother was Jedidah, the daughter of Adaiah from Bozkath. <sup>2</sup>He did what was pleasing in the Lord's sight and followed the example of his ancestor David. He did not turn away from doing what was right. <sup>3</sup>In the eighteenth year of his reign, King Josiah sent Shaphan son of Azaliah and grandson of Meshullam, the court secretary, to the Temple of the Lord. He told him, <sup>4</sup>"Go to Hilkiyah the high priest and have him count the money the gatekeepers have collected from the people at the Lord's Temple. <sup>5</sup>Entrust this money to the men assigned to supervise the restoration of the Lord's Temple. Then they can use it to pay workers to repair the Temple....

<sup>8</sup>Hilkiyah the high priest said to Shaphan the court secretary, "I have found the Book of the Law in the Lord's Temple!" Then Hilkiyah gave the scroll to Shaphan, and he read it. <sup>9</sup>Shaphan went to the king and reported, "Your officials have turned over the money collected at the Temple of the Lord to the workers and supervisors at the Temple." <sup>10</sup>Shaphan also told the king, "Hilkiyah the priest has given me a scroll." So Shaphan read it to the king. <sup>11</sup>When the king heard what was written in the Book of the Law, he tore his clothes in despair.
