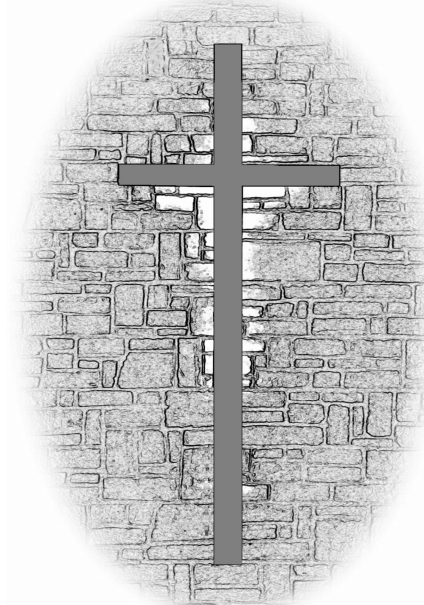

- ❖ Financial summaries for December and January were discussed. Tithe donations for 2024 were \$210,757, an increase of 1.95% over 2023. Local budget donations were \$129,276, a 22.34% increase over 2023.
- ❖ Several more opportunities for serving our neighbors in Miamisburg were discussed and will be shared soon. Threads of Miami Valley, 33 Lawrence Ave., in Miamisburg urgently needs new socks and underwear for men, women, and children. Donations may be left from 9-11:30 weekday mornings (except Tuesday).
- ❖ Dayton Eagles Pathfinders were servers for the Golden Buckeye Fellowship Christmas dinner and have been working on several honor patches. One honor brought a Pathfinder to us to tell the children's story. They had fun with the Lego honor, and participating in the Bible Experience.
- ❖ Pray for the principal search for Spring Valley Academy.
- ❖ The Acts 4:32 Ministry recently assisted with rent, U-Haul rental to help with donating furniture and accessories to refugees, with an internet bill to maintain essential contact, and food assistance.
