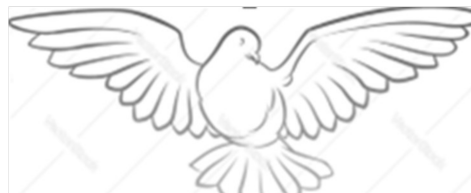
Potluck! There will be a potluck in the community center after church. Be aware that the bathrooms are still not available for use. Everyone is welcome to join us for good food and better fellowship!
