HOPE FOR HUMANITY

We are accountable for our partnership with our donors and supporters. 100% of donated funds are used for humanitarian projects—in local and statewide projects (50%), and around the world (50%). All promotional expenses are cared for by other resources, enabling Hope for Humanity to direct all donations to humanitarian projects.

By combining literacy with basic support, Hope for Humanity helps children not just survive, but thrive. When a child learns to read, they gain more than knowledge—they gain a future.
