

Message from the Principal

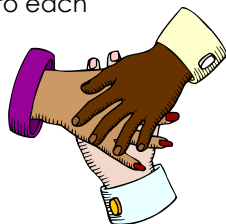
Greetings SVAE Family,

Arrival/Dismissal Schedule:

Attendance is taken at 8:05 a.m. Monday-Friday. **Students may arrive as early as 7:30 a.m.** classes begin at 8 a.m. every day. Dismissal is at 3:15 Monday-Thursday and Friday at 12 p.m. Please follow the traffic signs, and observe caution during drop-off and pick-up.

After School Care will be available again this year every day from 3:30-5:30 p.m. Monday-Thursday and 12:15-5:30 p.m. on Fridays. If your child is not picked up by 3:30, by default they will go to afterschool care with charges applied even if it is for a partial hour. The program will be coordinated by Christine Reinoehl. You will be billed twice a month for aftercare. Payments can be made in the office, Parents who anticipate using this service at any time this year should prepay for a few hours now. Please do not leave students in ASC unless needed.

All registration forms, including signed financial contracts, need to be turned in to the office in order for your child's registration to be complete. All forms are available on the school's website (www.svaelementary.org).

Planners for grades 5-8 (\$5 each) as well as **field trip shirts** (\$18 each) are available for purchase in the school office. All students are required to wear a red field trip shirt when on field trips. Please purchase one soon in the office.

The annual school social/open house, is Sunday August 25, from 1 p.m.-5 p.m. This is counted as a day of school, and attendance will be taken.

Piano Lessons at SVAE: If your child would like to learn to play the piano after school, please contact the office or Gerald White, at 335-8220. There will be time slots for eight students on Tuesday and Wednesday afternoons, starting at 3:30. Bells students will have preference for Wednesdays, and those with difficult schedules will be accommodated as necessary. Let me know of your interest **now**, so we can begin on Aug. 29. Thanks!

Hot lunch: We are pleased to offer healthy options that will feature fresh fruits & vegetables, whole grains and fewer processed foods. Lunches need to be prepaid (daily, weekly, etc.) in the office. A small lunch will be available for \$4.50. A regular meal will be available for \$5.50. Each *Parent Bulletin* will include the menu for the following week.

Hair length for boys should follow the following guidelines: Boys should maintain their hair length above the shirt collar, above the eyebrows, and so that part of the ear is visible. All should be complying by Monday, August 26.

Student Appearance: Parents, please review the policies in the handbook ("Responsibilities of Students" section) regarding hair, usage of jewelry/make-up/nail polish, and dress standards, as well as the consequences for non-compliance. For example, shorts and skirts should not be shorter than four inches above the knee. **Sweat pants and athletic shorts are not permitted during the academic day. Pull-over hooded sweat shirts are not permitted.** Your child's collar must be visible during class time. For your convenience, the handbook and dress code information sheet have been posted on our school website (www.svaelementary.org).

Lockers for students in grades 7-8 can be reserved on a first-come, first-served basis until Friday, August 30. The locker rental fee is \$10/year. This will include a combination lock from the school. At the end of the year when the lock is returned, a \$5 refund will be given. The extra \$5 fee will go towards supporting activities. Any extra lockers available on Monday, September 2, will be awarded on a first-come, first-served basis to 6th graders and then 5th graders on Sept. 9.

Tuition payments are due on the first of each month and are considered delinquent by the 10th of the month. For those families who are on a 12-month tuition payment plan, the first payment was due July 1. For those on the 10-month payment plan, the first payment was due on August 1.

No cell phones are allowed this year.

Bell ensemble tryouts for grades 5th -8th will be after school on Tuesday, Aug.20, from 3:30 – 4:30 p.m. with Mrs. FitzGerald.

Only 5th graders who have taken piano lessons can try out. Anyone in 6th-8th grade may try out.

RenWeb, our online information system which allows parents to view attendance, grade reports, homework assignments and more on any computer with Internet service will be available again this year to all families. Grade information will be available after the third week of the school year.

Use the new Box Tops app to scan your receipt. Box Tops are still worth 10 cents for your school. The app will find participating products purchased at any store and instantly add cash to your school's earnings online.

After-school Pick-ups: In order to allow parents to pick-up their students as quickly as possible after school, please follow these procedures:

- Stay to the right when approaching the school building.
- When your vehicle is in the "pick-up lane" beside the sidewalk in front of the school, pull your vehicle as far forward as possible. Your student(s) will walk down the sidewalk to meet your vehicle. Unless you are actively loading a student, there should not be a large space in front of your vehicle.

Parking Lot Safety Procedures:

- Please drive carefully—watching for children and vehicles when moving forward and into the "moving traffic" lane, maintaining low speeds.
- Parents who have business with the office or another staff member should park their vehicle and not use the "Pick-up lane."
- Pull into the "moving traffic lane" only after you have loaded your child(ren).
- Please do not drive around vehicles in front of you in the line to get into the "pick-up lane next to the sidewalk. This is important to reduce the likelihood of a run-in with another vehicle.
- Please do not back up in the pick-up lane as this is extremely dangerous. This is important to reduce the likelihood of running into another vehicle or child.
